4 WHEREAS, This Lunar New Year is the Year of the Rooster
5 and is universally celebrated by these communities as a time to
6 renew family ties, and to start the new year with a clean slate; and

7 WHEREAS, The celebration of the Lunar New Year in
8 communities throughout California illustrates the state’s rich
9 cultural history and commitment to racial, religious, and cultural
10 diversity; now, therefore, be it

11 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
12 *thereof concurring,* That the Members join Asian and Pacific
13 Islander communities throughout the state in celebrating January
14 28, 2017, as the beginning of the Lunar New Year, the Year of the
15 Rooster, and extend best wishes for a peaceful and prosperous
16 Lunar New Year to all Californians; and be it further

17 *Resolved,* That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies

SUBJECT: Lunar New Year Celebration

SUMMARY: Recognizes the Lunar New Year Celebration beginning on January 28, 2017. Specifically, **this resolution** makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) January 28, 2017, will mark the beginning of the Lunar New Year which is celebrated in many Asian communities around the world, including the United States, and especially California.
- 2) California is home to nearly 6 million Asian and Pacific Islander Americans of Bangladeshi, Cambodian, Chinese, Filipino, Hmong, Indian, Indonesian, Iu-Mien, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Malaysian, Pakistani, Sri Lankan, Taiwanese, and Vietnamese descent.
- 3) The Lunar New Year is predominately celebrated by 2.5 million Chinese, Korean, and Vietnamese residents of California.
- 4) The celebration of the Lunar New Year in communities throughout California reflects the rich cultural history and commitment to racial, religious, and cultural diversity.
- 5) The 2017 Lunar New Year is the Year of the Rooster and is a time to renew family ties and start the New Year with a clean slate.
