RE: Request to Add Urgency Clause to Senate Bill 372 (Cannella)

Dear Chair Cooley,

I hereby request permission to add an urgency clause to my SB 372. The measure creates the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors Groundwater Sustainability Agency within my district. The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) requires local agencies in high or medium priority groundwater basins to submit a Notification of Intent to serve as a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) no later than June 30, 2017. Lands which are not within the boundary of a GSA as of June 30, 2017 are considered 'unmanaged.' Landowners within unmanaged areas are subject to mandatory groundwater extraction reporting requirements and fees (Water Code § 5202). Unmanaged areas are also subject to "probationary" designation and possibly state intervention (Water Code § 10735.2(a)).

Though the Exchange Contractors Authority submitted its Notification of Intent to be a GSA on December 22, 2015, questions have been raised regarding the consistency of that Notification with the provisions of SGMA. The addition of an urgency clause would eliminate any uncertainty concerning the applicability of Water Code Sections 5202 and 10735.2 within the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors GSA service territory immediately upon passage of SB 372 into law. This urgency measure would provide a needed measure of security and certainty to the Exchange Contractor Authority members and landowners who reside within their boundaries.
