WHEREAS, Red Nose Day is a fundraising campaign run by the nonprofit organization Comic Relief, Inc., a registered United States 501(c)(3) public charity. Comic Relief, Inc., in the United States and Comic Relief in the United Kingdom are independent sister organizations joined by their shared vision of a just world,

free from poverty, and the mission to drive positive change through 18

20 WHEREAS, From April 17 to June 3, inclusive, Walgreens and Duane Reade locations nationwide will sell red noses for \$1 each 21 with all Walgreens' profits from all sales benefitting the Red Nose
