ACR 74, as introduced, Bigelow. California Fairground Appreciation Month

This measure would designate June 2015 as California Fairground Appreciation Month and commend the directors, volunteers, staff, local agencies, and nonprofits, as well as the Californians who support and attend fairground events.

SUBJECT: California Fairground Appreciation Month.

SUMMARY: Designates June 2015 as California Fairground Appreciation Month and commends the directors, volunteers, staff, local agencies, and nonprofits, as well as the Californians who support and attend fairground events. Specifically, **this resolution** makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) California's 76 fairgrounds represent an important public asset, providing public recreation, education, and community unity to over twenty million Californians every year.
- 2) California's fairgrounds provide vital emergency services as fire camps, disaster relief centers, training, and staging areas as well as serving as year-round centers for economic activities generating millions of dollars in tax and employment income for the state and local governments.
- 3) California's fairgrounds promote both the Golden State's proud agricultural history and the education of future generations about the connection between food and farming and promote water conservation and the importance of water to California farms and cities.
- 4) California's fairgrounds are gathering places for the state's diverse ethnic populations, veterans groups, and other organizations.
